Exclusion Zone Security Gates

The NSW Darling Walk project is using this security solution as a cheap and quick solution to prevent people entering exclusion zones while work is being performed overhead and to manage access. This solution is an effective way to manage exclusion zones to prevent access and the outcomes are secure exclusion zones and easier management of walkway's and NO ACCESS areas. Electric Concrete Vibrator

The team at Brisbane Supreme Court & District Court have been using a permanent scissor mounted electric concrete vibrator used to mitigate noise and emissions during concrete placement activities for columns whilst in a confined space. It effectively eliminates noise and emissions during vibration activities whilst also allowing free movement around the scissor lift work platform without vibrator impediments. Plasterboard Lifting Pallets

The Myer Team at Victoria Harbour are using these robust lifting pallets to lift plasterboard safely. They are manufactured by La Farge and arrive to site packed on these pallets, ready to be lifted. They are constructed with coach bolts, steel plates for extra strength through the chain channels allowing plaster to be lifted safely. All plaster comes to sited banded up. 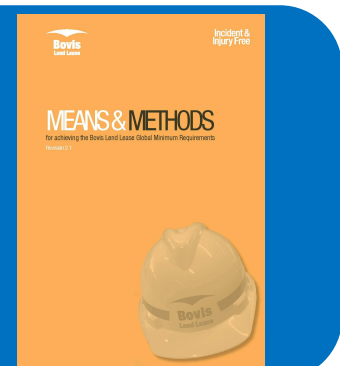

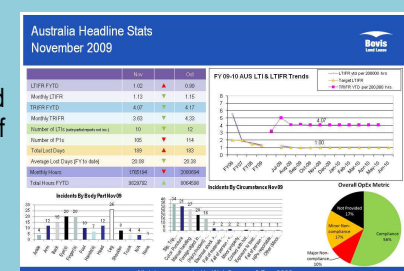
